



<u>Integrations</u>

- 4 If the display type is selected as floating, a sticky button will be displayed on the right side of the webpage which will open the modal with the form when selected.

If the display type is floating, a mandatory **Icon** field will be displayed to select/upload a SVG icon to be displayed on the floating button. The floating button colour is the primary brand colour so ensure the icon colour contrasts with this colour and is on a transparent background.

Complete the required details, then select Save.




